NORDIC SKIING AND SNOWSHOEING RESPONSIBILITY CODE

THERE ARE ELEMENTS OF RISK THAT COMMON SENSE AND PERSONAL AWARENESS CAN HELP REDUCE. REGARDLESS OF HOW YOU DECIDE TO USE THE TRAILS AND FACILITIES, ALWAYS SHOW COURTESY TO OTHERS. PLEASE ADHERE TO THE CODE LISTED BELOW AND SHARE WITH OTHERS THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A SAFE OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE

1. Nakkertok's ski and snowshoe trails are not regularly patrolled. Please ensure that you ski / snowshoe with others, or that someone is informed of where you are and when you expect to return. It is advisable to carry a cell phone with you, but coverage is limited in areas.
2. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
3. Observe trail conditions and adjust activities and selection of trails accordingly.
4. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them. Let them know if and how you want to pass.
5. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
6. Be aware of any open water or thin ice. Just above and below beaver dams, and where water is flowing are high risk areas. You can break through ice even on the coldest winter day.
7. Be aware of any low hanging, or fallen branches or trees.
8. Keep away from snowmaking equipment, including hydrants, the pump house, the pumps, and the generator
9. Leave any wildlife alone
10. Obey all signs, ski in indicated direction, and keep off of closed trails.
11. Report any incidents
