PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING POINTS OF TRAIL AND FACILITY USAGE ETIQUETTE. NON-MEMBERS AND GUESTS OF MEMBERS PLEASE PAY DAY FEES

- 1. Read and understand the Ski and Snowshoe Responsibility Code
- 2. Downhill skiers have right-of-way. Please give them space to pass.
- When coming up behind a slower skier, indicate if and how you would like to pass. I.e. "Track Please" or "Passing on your left"
- 4. Please do not leave litter on trails or in any cabin. We prefer that you take your litter and recyclables home.
- 5. Do not walk on any ski or snowshoe trail during the winter season
- 6. Please ski on the right side of the trail where possible. When approaching an oncoming skier or snowshoer stay right and say "hello".
- 7. If stopping to rewax, reconnect, rehydrate, or repair, please move to the side of the trail

- 8. Do not skate ski over classic tracks or on classic only trails
- 9. If Mother Nature calls, use the various outhouses, or if caught between, go off of the trail and cover your art.
- 10. If you are the first to arrive, feel free to start a fire in the wood stoves, move back the ski racks, and remove snow from the door access points.
- 11. If you are the last to leave Nakkertok, please damper down the woodstove, extinguish any candles and lock all doors.
- 12. No dogs on any other ski or snowshoe trail or inside any building during winter season
